

Shipboard Information

Security Notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship you are required to carry your 'Cruise Card' with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. It may be prudent that you carry a Government issued picture ID with you before leaving the ship, as you may be required to show this at security checkpoints upon our arrival. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your Cruise Card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the security staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship. We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Going Ashore Independently

The local taxi association in Gibraltar operates a paid shuttle service by minibus from outside the cruise ship terminal to the bottom of 'Main Street' in the town centre. The driver will charge £2 per person each way. Queues may be experienced when using this service due to high demand. Alternatively, if you are feeling energetic it is a short walk of around 15 - 20 minutes to the town centre on a flat level pavement. These taxis are unfortunately not wheelchair accessible.

Hand Washing

You are reminded that in a confined environment such as a ship, viruses can be easily transferred. Hand washing is a simple and effective method of reducing the risk of contamination. In addition we ask you to make use of the alcohol hand gel prior to entering our food service areas.

To avoid losing your emails, personal information or internet page our internet is designed to continue browsing, if you are due to come to the end of your Internet price plan. Once your purchased minutes have run out you will be taken on to a pay per minute system and charged for every minute that you stay online. 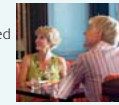
