IMMIGRATION NOTICE

There will be a Face To Face Immigration Check starting at 8:15am, guests are asked to go at their allocated time, as per their immigration card they have received. Guests who do not wish to leave the ship before 9:30am will need to go to the terminal at 9:30am, where they will wait until the ship has completed the immigration clearance. Guests disembarking the ship on April 9th will also need to proceed to immigration and customs at 9:30am.

Azamara Journey is scheduled to dock at the Manhattan Cruise Terminal in New York at approximately 8:00am.

New York City conjures countless images, from such architectural icons as the Empire State Building, the Chrysler Building and Rockefeller Center to Central Park, Times Square and the Statue of Liberty. Famous the world over, the five boroughs of New York (Manhattan, Brooklyn, the Bronx, Queens and Staten Island) comprise the biggest city in the U.S. The lights of Broadway, world-renowned restaurants, nightlife for every taste—boredom is impossible here in "the city that never sleeps." Deciding how to spend your time here in the Big Apple? With so many options from which to choose, that will take some thought.

BRIEF HISTORY

Archaeological evidence proves the first indigenous people settled around present-day New York roughly 12,000 years ago. The Lenape ("original people") had established seasonal settlements up and down the coast well before Giovanni da Verrazano explored the area aboard the French ship La Dauphine in 1524. Henry Hudson visited in 1609 on behalf of the Dutch West Indies Company, which went on to establish a permanent trading post (Nieuw-Amsterdam) here in 1624. After a couple of years of bloody skirmishes with the Lenapes, Governor Peter Minuit struck the most famous real estate deal of all time when his offer to purchase 14,000 acres for the equivalent of \$24 was accepted by the misled natives. By 1664, British battle ships arrived, ready to fight the Dutch for control of the region, which they obtained without firing a shot. Renamed New York after King Charles II's brother, the port city prospered and expanded rapidly, achieving a population of around 11,000 by the mid-1700s. New Yorkers, along with most other colonists, eventually chafed under the taxes and regulations of their absentee rulers, readily joining in the uprising known as the American Revolution. After the war, the city continued to prosper and grow—over half of all the people and goods that have ever entered the United States have come through New York. The rich history and multiculturalism of this dynamic metropolis continues to entice people from around the world today.

HIGHLIGHTS

Space does not allow us to list more than a handful of New York's "must see" attractions (some of which we've mentioned above) so we will focus on a few which may not be quite so familiar:

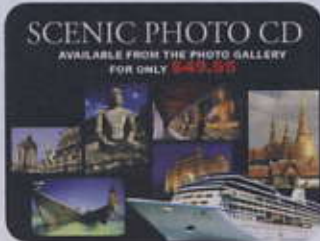
- A water taxi, ferry or catamaran excursion is a great way to see many of Manhattan's famous buildings along with the Statue of Liberty.
- A defunct elevated railway line once used to carry goods directly from factories is now the popular High Line Park, featuring public art, comfy lounge chairs and splendid views of the Hudson River.
- Chelsea Market, housed in the original Nabisco factory where the first Oreos were baked, is "foodie heaven," with over two dozen specialty shops and eateries.
- Formally dedicated on 11 September 2011, the National September 11 Memorial & Museum is a shrine to the nearly 3000 people who lost their lives in the terrorist attacks here in New York, in Pennsylvania and at the Pentagon. The somber site features reflecting pools in the footprints of the fallen twin towers, edged by bronze panels bearing the names of the victims.
