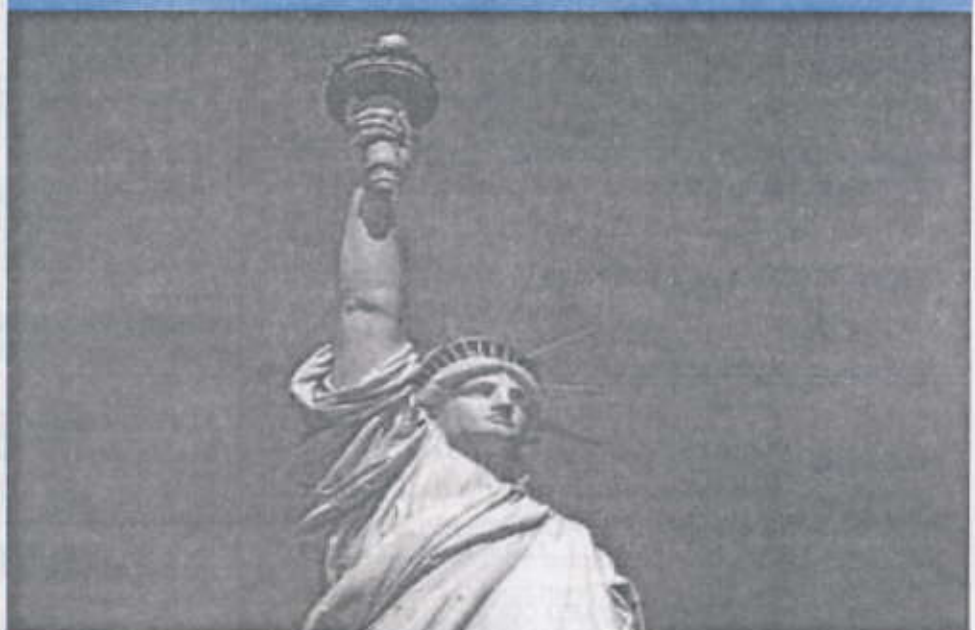

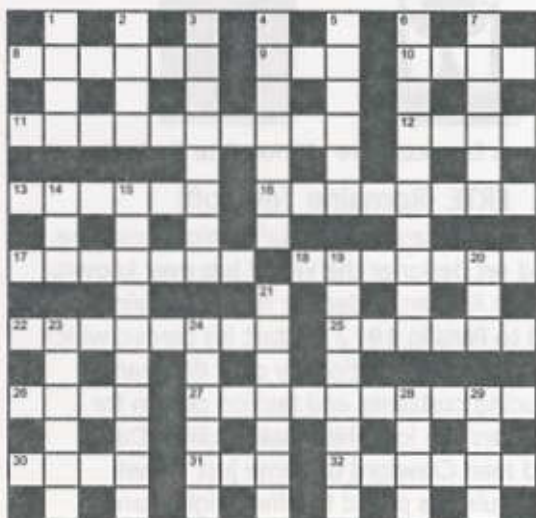

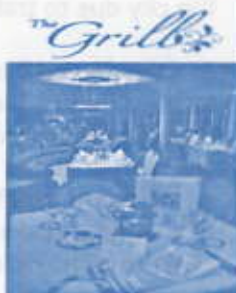

## Cruise Card

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are asked to carry your Cruise Card with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship.

## Security

Please be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your Cruise Card when leaving or boarding the ship. We ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags that you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

## Postage

Stamps for each port are sold for sterling cash only and are available at the Reception Desk during opening hours. Outgoing mail, bearing local postage stamps, may be posted up to 5.30pm today. Stamps for a postcard from New York to the rest of the world cost £0.53p.

## Currency for port of call

The local currency for New York is the Dollar which is sold onboard and can be purchased from the Reception Desk on Deck 2 at the following rates.

We buy £1 = \$1.97

We sell £1 = \$1.79

The highest Dollar note we accept onboard is \$50.00. We cannot exchange foreign coins.

## PASSPORT / NATIONAL ID

You are advised that the Department of Homeland Security requires all visitors to carry some form of national photo ID (such as a Driving Licence) on their person when going ashore in the US. You must also carry the green Departure Record slip, which was returned to you at the immigration inspection.

## US DEPT. OF AGRICULTURE REQUIREMENTS

During our calls at all American ports, the US Department of Agriculture has instructed that foodstuffs (including biscuits) or products derived from plant origin (such as fruit) may NOT be taken ashore. Only sealed mineral water bottles may be taken off the ship for personal use. Severe penalties exist for any infringements to this instruction.

## FAREWELL MESSAGE FROM CAPTAIN DAVID BOX

I would like to wish you all farewell and a very pleasant onward cruise up the exciting and historical coast of New England during the next few days. At midday today I expect to hand over command of the good ship Artemis to Captain Paul Brown and I leave your goodselves and the ship in his very capable and experienced hands. It has been a pleasure having you all on board, sharing our American Adventure, over the last 3 weeks and I look forward to welcoming you back aboard Artemis in the future.

## WASHING OF HANDS

Passengers are reminded that in a confined environment such as a ship, viruses can be easily transferred. Regular hand washing for at least 20 seconds is a simple and effective method of reducing the risk of contamination.

## ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES

We wish to caution passengers when ashore, that drugs are available and frequently offered for sale. Please do not be coerced into purchasing these substances, as, in most cases, **you will be caught.**

P&O Cruises has a zero tolerance policy with regard to the unlawful possession of drugs. Local law enforcement agencies have become especially vigilant in their efforts to eradicate both drug abuse and trafficking, and these efforts have included subjecting passengers to physical search (including strip search) on return to the ship.

## DISPOSAL OF BATTERIES

P&O Cruises operate a strict environmental policy regarding the disposal of waste. With this in mind we would remind all passengers to dispose of all batteries in the bin provided by the Photo Gallery on Deck 3 or hand them in to your Cabin Steward/ess. Thank you for your support and co-operation.
