IMMIGRATION

Please carry your **cruise card, I-94 Departure Slip and Passport** when going ashore. You will be asked to produce your cruise card when going ashore and when returning to the ship. Keep your cruise card safe to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship.

SECURITY

We will establish a secure area around the vessel and our procedures require you to show your cruise card to the security staff when entering both the port area and ship's secure area. Additionally, you must register your cruise card at the podium at the top of the gangway each time you enter and leave the ship. Please do not accept parcels or objects from anyone for delivery either on or off the ship. Should you receive such items, please notify the Reception Desk or security staff immediately. P&O Cruises operates a 100% screening process for all persons and baggage returning on board and this involves passing through a security X-Ray arch. Passengers with pacemakers should advise security staff in order that alternative arrangements can be made.

POSTAGE

Incoming mail will be delivered to cabins. Outgoing mail, bearing local postage stamps, may be posted up to one hour before our departure. Stamps for a postcard to the UK can be purchased for sterling only at the Reception Desk and cost 55p each.

CASH AND CURRENCY FACILITIES

Foreign currency is available at Reception as detailed below. Should you wish to encash a foreign travellers cheque the conversion will be subject to on board exchange rates. There will be no charge for the encashment of sterling personal cheques and sterling travellers cheques into sterling. For information the current exchange rates are:

DISEMBARKATION ARRANGEMENTS FOR TODAY'S TOURS

Passengers on tours this morning are requested to meet in **The Curzon Theatre** at the times
indicated below. **Please enter on the starboard side.** You should collect a sticker from the staff
in attendance. This sticker will indicate which tour coach you are to join. If you are travelling in a
group, please advise the staff so that seats may be allocated on the same tour coach. You should
then take a seat and wait until your tour and coach number is called.

Passengers are advised that the mustering times are slightly earlier than usual. This is to
allow time for passengers to disembark the ship and proceed through the terminal
building and down the escalators to the roadside, which is where the tour buses will be
parked.

Tour tickets should be retained and handed to the guide as you board the coach.
