

### Wireless Sign-On Procedure



Please proceed to the Computer Center on deck-6, (with your laptop) to set up your wireless account, (with the assistance of a Computer instructor), for the first time.

- Set up your ID and Password at the Computer Center by selecting the "Wireless" option, swiping your stateroom card and following the on-screen instructions.
- 2. Turn on your laptop's wireless switch.
- 3. Connect to the network called 'Celebrity-Wifi'.
- Open Internet Explorer to be redirected to Celebrity's log in page as shown in the image above.
- 5. Turn off pop up blockers; deactivate toolbars and firewalls.
- 6. Enter the user ID and Password.
- 7. Bookmark 'Log on/off' page, for easy log-out.

## Important Reminders

In order to ensure maximum satisfaction with your internet transactions, please be sure to familiarize yourself with these helpful tips.

You must log off properly. Go to the log-off page to log off and stop charges to your account.

- Guests are responsible for internet charges, if not logged off properly.
- Charges will continue while online and the use of internet is at your own discretion.
- No refunds for slow connections or disconnections.
- If your page or any page you are trying to open takes longer than 30 seconds to load/open, please log off immediately and try again at a later time.
- Simply closing your web browser or turning off your machine, does not stop the minutes from running and may result in additional charges.
- If you wish to share an internet package, the same SeaPass card must be used.
- Unused minutes are not refundable. If you exceeded the package minutes during an internet session, the additional minutes will be charged at the package rate until that session is logged off. The choice of purchasing another package, or the 'per minute rate' will be presented the next time you log on.
- Internet Access will terminate at 7:00am on Debarkation Day. Any unused package minutes are non-refundable.
- If you are sailing on consecutive voyages, you must purchase a separate package for each voyage.
- Connection speed onboard is not as fast as the connection you have at home. Intermittent satellite connection may be experienced occasionally depending on the ship's location, military interference or weather conditions.
- For questions regarding your internet charges or access please contact us within 24 hours of the event concerned.
- Celebrity Cruiseline only provides internet and cannot guarantee access to all websites. Some banking, financial, government sites, corporate VPN's, Outlook/Mail and VOIP applications (i.e. Skype, Magic Jack) are NOT supported.
