Bridgetown, Barbados

The easternmost island of the West Indies, pear-shaped Barbados combines beautiful beaches with ingenuous British charm to produce one of the Caribbean's most popular destinations. The west coast of the island is lined with over 10 miles of perfect white-sand beaches with perfectly clear water. This is why this piece of paradise has been dubbed the "Platinum Coast."

Barbados is mostly a flat coral island, but there are rolling hills and many deep ridges and gullies, with an interesting distribution of flora and fauna. Within the Barbados coral core, there is a vast array of caves and underground lakes which provide an excellent supply of drinking water that is amongst the purest in the world. Geologically Barbados is unique, being actually two land masses that merged together over the years.

Highlights

The capital city of Bridgetown is a bustling architectural hodgepodge, filled with both modern and Victorian/colonial buildings. Its main thoroughfare, Broad Street, is lined with the city's best shops. Sights within easy walking distance include Trafalgar Square, Parliament Buildings, Fountain Garden, and St. Michael's Anglican Cathedral. Additional highlights include:

- **Holetown:** small old St. James coast settlement where the British first landed.
- **Gold Coast:** nickname for the shore along St. James and St. Peter parishes; this is where island's most glamorous hotels and residences are located.
- **Barbados Wildlife Reserve:** mahogany forest home to thousands of rare green monkeys, and other wildlife.
- **Farley Hill:** 30 acres of national park with grand old trees and stunning views.
- **Andromeda Gardens:** Filled with superb tropical flora.
- **Sam Lord's Castle:** grand home of the celebrated 19th century rogue.

Shore Excursions

Barbados is truly a place for water adventures and we recommend any beach or snorkeling tours as a must for the day. For those of you looking for a more relaxing day with a Caribbean flair, try any of the tours that visit the Rum Factory or the Harrison's Cave. For a great last minute tour take a ride on the Tiami catamaran. You will swim and snorkel at turtle bay with sea turtles followed by a stop at a white sandy beach. An amazing day that shouldn't be missed! Inquire with your Shore Excursions staff and don't miss out on the wonder of Barbados.

Also, if you are not sure of what to do in Grenada stop by the Emporium on Deck 5 Midship at 8:00pm and learn about the Isle of Spice, and the tours available there.

Camouflaged Clothing Forbidden in Barbados

When going ashore, please be aware that camouflage material of any sort whether clothing, hats, rucksack, swimwear or other articles is completely prohibited in Barbados.

Very Important – Barbados Public Smoking Ban

On October 1st 2010, Barbados enacted legislation banning the smoking of tobacco in public spaces in accordance with the Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (FCTC) with fines and imprisonment chosen as punishment for illegal smokers. Smokers found guilty of breaking the law face a maximum BDS\$500 (US\$250) fine or a 12-month prison term, or both. Please be aware of this important law to ensure a smoke-free environment for Barbadians and, indeed, all visitors to this beautiful country.
