Tortola and Virgin Gorda, British Virgin Islands

Sprinkled around the Sir Francis Drake Channel like ink spots on a blue sea, the 60-plus British Virgin Islands, totaling only 60 square miles in area, have a population of about 12,000, and about as many hidden coves and cays spread over their 50 spectacular miles.

Northeast of the U.S.V.I., the westernmost island of the B.V.I. is less than a mile from the U.S.'s St. John island, and the entire archipelago is just 60 miles east of Puerto Rico. Most of the islands are mere rocks, fragments of coral, or volcanic atolls, and only about ten are populated, including Tortola, Virgin Gorda, Beef Island, Anegada (furthest north and farthest from the others by 10 miles), and Jost Van Dyke.

After Columbus discovered and named the Virgin Islands in 1493, he – and most other explorers who navigated the tricky and treacherous channels – forgot about the chain until 1595 when Sir Francis Drake sailed into the channel that now bears his name. The usual Caribbean spate of territorial takeovers by Spain and the Netherlands erupted over the next 100 years, but the English government officially annexed Tortola in 1672, and after another century of pirates and buccaneers occupying the islands' many caves and coves, the British won out.

Early in this century, economic links with the U.S.V.I. became stronger than

with the West Indies Federation (of British territories), and although the islands remain a British Crown Colony where decidedly British traditions remain, the U.S. dollar is now coin of the realm.

Virgin Gorda

Until the early 1960s when Laurance Rockefeller's love for Virgin Gorda's beauty and isolation resulted in the first resort here, the craggy ten-mile stretch of cays and bays had a population of 50, tourism was an unknown term, and the island had no power, roads, or services.

Fortunately, the original natural appeal of the island remains, and only a few of the beaches have been carefully trimmed with small resorts. The 1,000 residents now welcome limited numbers of tourists, who come here for the quiet beauty and the remote talcum powder beaches. Some come to marvel at the island's main attraction – The Baths – a scenic wonder of huge boulders surrounding glassy lakes on the island's southern end. The fat virgin, as Virgin Gorda's name translates, is simply sensational and sensationally simple.

Tortola

Inhabited more by the turtle doves that inspired its name than by the mere 9,000+ human residents, Tortola is another of nature's wonders, offering some of world's most beautiful and undeveloped beaches, unsurpassed snorkeling and diving opportunities, and ultimate photogenic vistas. This is the main British Virgin island. Road Town, the B.V.I.'s capital, business center, and most populated city, is where most of the island's activity begins and ends. There are dozens of shops along Main Street, and although liquor and perfume purchases are perhaps better bargains on St. Thomas, this is a British duty-free port, so some English china, foods, and fabrics are bargain-priced. Local goods include shell jewelry, coral creations, and light-weight resort wear.

Taxis are readily available here; rates are fixed and fair. The island is only 11 miles long and three miles at the widest, so a quick tour of this unspoiled paradise of the Atlantic is possible.

the west leads to Mt. Sage, the island's highest peak (1,780 feet) and the focal point of Sage Mountain National Park. Its slopes, once a primeval rain forest, make an ideal spot for a picnic with unparalleled views of the neighboring islands and cays. The beautiful coast road continues past the 1660 Dutch-built Fort Recovery, the tiny town of West End where ferries head to and from nearby St. John and St. Thomas, then on around to the north coast, site of the island's – and many say the world's – finest beaches. A dozen named bays and twice as many unnamed coves line the Atlantic side of the island. Smuggler's Cove has unmatched snorkeling; the mile-long beach at Long Bay is ideal for sunning and swimming; surfing is at its finest at Apple Bay; Cane Garden Bay's mile-and-a-half-long sands are among

the Caribbean's most handsome and picturesque.

The road continues east through tropical forests, past bays and sea vistas, and after the towns of Long Swamp, Parham Town, and East End, leads to the Queen Elizabeth Bridge (dedicated by Her Majesty in 1966) to Beef Island, site of the international airport, launch departures for tiny, unpopulated Bellamy and Marina Cays, and more untrammelled sunning, swimming, and shelling beaches.

The short five-mile drive back to Road Town takes you by Fat Hogs Bay, past more picture-postcard-perfect vistas of secluded beaches and bays, and through the village of Kingstown, where you'll have a great view of the ship anchored in Road Bay.

Wonderful Water Sports

True seafarers and sailors may want to forgo the landlubbers island tour and head for the marina, where dozens of commercial establishments offer sailing excursions, boat rentals, or snorkeling and scuba diving trips. The British Virgin Islands' natural surroundings are nothing less than superb and spectacular, and any outing on or in the water will prove a memorable experience. The variety of offshore shipwrecks, plus underwater flora and fauna in the diamond-clear waters are magnificent.

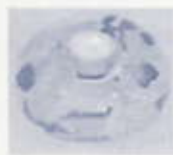

No Visitors On Board

For security reasons, Celebrity Cruises is unable to allow visitors aboard its ships.

Misuse of Drugs Act 1972

All persons entering each port are warned that it is a CRIMINAL OFFENSE to import or have possession of narcotics and other controlled drugs, including marijuana. Penalties for drug offenders are severe. Guests with prescribed controlled drugs must declare them to Customs.

Liquor Purchased Ashore / Onboard

Alcoholic beverages purchased ashore will be collected at the gangway and stored in a safe place until the last night of the cruise, at which time it – and any other duty-free alcoholic beverage purchased on board – will be delivered to your stateroom. It is against regulations for duty-free alcoholic beverages purchased during the cruise to be consumed on board.
