NAUTICAL INFORMATION

After leaving The Big Apple, we'll sail with the pilot on board through the Hudson River. After 45 minutes, on the starboard side of the ship, we will see the Statue of Liberty. After this, we'll pass under the Verrazano Bridge on the Ambrose Channel; the pilot will disembark and the ship will sail to Sydney.

EMERGENCY DRILL

A General Emergency Drill for all passengers will be carried out today (at 4:30pm). The participation of all passengers is compulsory according to the International Regulations for the Safety of Life at Sea. When you hear the emergency signal (consisting of seven short blasts followed by one long blast) please go to your cabin, wear your life jacket and proceed to your Assembly Station (all the instructions are indicated on a note board behind your cabin door). All the ship's services will be closed during the drill. If for any reason of disability or illness you cannot attend the drill, please inform your cabin steward.

FIRE: OUR BIGGEST DANGER

While firemen constantly check the ship, please join us with vigilance. If you detect smoke, use the break-glass alarms that are situated throughout the ship to alert the Bridge. Observe the non-smoking areas. Never smoke on cabin balconies. Never throw lighted cigarettes overboard. Never smoke in bed and never smoke as you walk around the ship. Smoke only in Smoking areas and always use ashtrays.



SMOKING AREAS

We kindly ask all guests who smoke to respect the areas where smoking is not permitted. *Smoking is permitted on the Port side (left) of the open decks, in the Bar del Poeti, portside (Dk. 6), Pigalle Lounge (Dk. 7), Cigar Room (Dk.7), in the whole Casino Royal (Dk. 7); Piraña Bar and Mojito Bar (except for the bar counter); open pool area (Dk. 13) and open decks, near the elevators, port side (Dk. 14); Solarium (port side).*

-Cigar Room, deck 7
-Royal Casino, deck 7
-Pigalle Lounge, deck 7

-S32 Disco and the aft outer decks, deck 14 are considered non-smoking areas. Smoking is allowed on the outer part of deck 14, portside, near the exit of the MiniClub.
Smoking is not permitted on any cabin balcony, and is strongly discouraged in all cabins. Please do not walk through corridors or passageways smoking cigarettes. Smoking pipes and cigars is allowed only at the Hitchcock Lounge Cigar Room Dk 7.



YOUR CRUISE CARD

The MSC Cruise Card received at embarkation serves as your personal identification, cabin key and "Cruise Credit Card" that will be used to purchase all products and services on board. At the end of the cruise, you may pay your bill using Visa, MasterCard, Diners, American Express or JCB cards. If you pre-registered your cruise card when you embarked, you are able to settle your account using cash, Traveller's checks (with a 3% commission) or Eurochecks when you embarked. For your records, a detailed statement will be sent to your cabin at the end of the cruise. Alternatively you can view your accounting status at anytime from the comfort of your own cabin using your interactive television. For security reasons the Cruise Card must be shown at the gangway every time you go ashore or return to the ship.



ELECTRIC CURRENT

Voltage: 110/220v. Only electrical appliances allowed in cabins: shavers, hairdryers, battery chargers, computers and cabin fixtures (heat-generating and ironing appliances forbidden). MSC is not responsible for damage to electrical appliances caused by Guests. Cabin Stewards will disconnect any personal apparatus plugged into power points when cabins are unattended.



SERVICE CHARGE

We would like to remind you that MSC has adopted a new service charge policy which replaces our former tipping and gratuities policy, as published on our websites and brochures. This service charge has the purpose of maintaining the highest quality standards in passenger service. It will only be requested at the end of the cruise and will depend on the number of days that services are actually provided. We invite you to check our Internet sites and should you have any further questions, please, do not hesitate to contact the Guest Relations Manager. We use this opportunity to emphasize that no tips are requested on board.



A HEALTHY SHIP

In order to prevent colds, the flu and stomachaches wash your hands thoroughly with soap and hot water after using the bathroom. Use a clean paper towel to open bathroom doors after washing hands. Please also make use of hand sanitizers that are positioned around the ship.



SAVE THE SEA

Do not throw anything overboard while the vessel is at sea or in port. Use wastebaskets and trash cans placed around the ship. MSC is doing everything in its power to protect the sea. Help us to save the maritime life, and preserve this beautiful resource.



CABIN CHANGES

Please note that as MSC Poesia is fully booked for this cruise it is not possible to make any cabin changes or upgrades. If you wish to place your name on the waiting list in case embarking Guests do not arrive in following ports, please contact Reception.



MEDICAL EMERGENCY (TEL. 115)

The telephone number for any Medical Emergency is 115. This number is displayed prominently in every cabin door and it should be used only in case of a real Medical Emergency.



TEEN CARD

The "Teen Card" is a prepaid card unique and exclusive for our younger passengers. Easy to use and full of advantages, these cards are available with \$30.00 or \$50.00 credit per card. Children and teenagers under the age of 18 can use the card to buy anything they want onboard and use it as an access card for their cabin. Depending on the amount chosen, you will receive an additional bonus of \$5.00 (when choosing the \$30.00 card) and \$10.00 (if you buy the \$50.00 card). To buy a Teen Card, you only need to fill in the form you will find at the Reception, at the Accounting Desk (deck 5) and at the Virtual Game (deck 14). The card will be delivered directly in your cabin! **The Teen Card is non refundable**, therefore any amount left on the card at the end of the cruise will not be reimbursed.



ALCOHOL POLICY

Alcoholic drinks are available in all bars and restaurants for Guests over the age of 18 (proof of age may be required). Guests are not permitted to bring any beverages (alcoholic or nonalcoholic) on board for consumption during the cruise. Any bottles detected in carry-on or checked baggage at embarkation will be kept and returned to the Guest at the end of the Cruise. Alcohol purchased in the ship's shops will be delivered directly to your cabin the night before you disembark.



POOL CAUTION

Always shower before entering the swimming pools. Diving, jumping or running around the pool is not permitted. There is no lifeguard on duty at the pools. Please read the important health advisory notices (at the Pool and Spa Pool area) before you enter any pools. Children are not permitted in adult pools; moreover, concerning hygiene, any person wearing diapers is not permitted in any pool or spa.



POOL TOWELS & DECK CHAIRS

Deck chairs are available for your enjoyment in the pool area, sun decks and on the aft section of most accommodation decks. These chairs may not be reserved or held unused for long periods. Swimming Pool towels are provided directly at the Pool. Any personal items found on unattended deck chairs will be taken to Reception.



SAFETY EVERYWHERE

In the interests of your safety, please avoid running around the ship - particularly at the pool areas. Take care in areas that may have been washed down, always use hand-rails and keep fingers away from open doors.

SAFETY BRACELETS FOR CHILDREN

Right after you embark our safety personnel will provide you a yellow bracelet and an appropriate fitting life jackets for all children under the age of 12. The bracelet indicates your muster station. Please write your cabin number and name of your child in the space provided (with a ballpoint pen). **This bracelet is to be worn for the whole duration of the cruise.**



CHILDREN AND EMERGENCIES

In case of an emergency while your child is under our supervision, we will lead them to the designated children's 'pick up' areas. The 'pick-up' area for this ship is the *Cyber Cafe, Deck 7*. Parents are then required to take their children to their assigned Muster Stations as indicated on the emergency signs behind each cabin door.



CHILD CARE

Babysitting is not available on MSC Poesia. Only children over the age of 3 are permitted in the Mini Club. Guests on excursions who wish to leave their children (3 or older) with our child care team should contact the Mini Club Staff in the "1 Dinosaur", deck 14.
