## WELCOME!

Norwegian Cruise Line enthusiastically welcomes families and children on board our ships, and we've designed a special program to make this cruise an enjoyable experience for the entire family. To give parents those needed moments alone and at the same time let them know their children are not only having fun but are safe, we have put together a highly trained staff, each of whom is certified in CPR and first aid, so your child will be safe and secure at all times.

Every day, children ages 9 to 12 can participate in complimentary activities designed especially for them. Don't think this is a babysitting program - there's very little sitting involved! Our activities are active, energetic, educational and most important, fun. Tweens will get involved in arts and crafts, trivia, sports, theme nights, games and parties - activities that will inspire their imagination. And best of all, it's included in the fare!

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Parent(s)/guardian(s) must complete the one-time registration form for any child who is 2 to 12 years of age. After that, registered children can participate as often as they like.
- Children are assigned to appropriate age groups based on age at sailing date. For the safety of all participants, no exceptions can be made - unless a child celebrates a birthday during the cruise, of course!
- Identification bracelets will be used at ALL times for children ages 2 to 12 within the programs. Bracelets are required for both day and evening programs.
- Proper footwear is required. Please no flip-flops or sandals.
- Children under age 13 may NOT sign themselves out of the program and walk through the ship unattended. Older brothers and sisters (unless they're 21 years or older and have signed the registration form) may not sign out a young family member under the age of 13.
- Children with any symptoms of illness may be required to be evaluated at the medical center before being admitted to the Youth Programs.
- Parents with young children in diapers or pull-ups will be issued beepers to let them know when the child needs to be changed or requires attention. Beeper range is limited to the ship. Youth staff are not able to assist children in the washrooms or change diapers or pull-ups.
- Parents must present an ID with signature; the signature must match that on the registration form. When the Youth Counselor KNOWS the family member, it is not necessary to check each time.
- Private or one-on-one care is not available.

## SAFETY:

In the event of an emergency during program hours, the Child Care Team is responsible for mustering the children in their care and bringing them safely to the Child Muster Station, where the children will be claimed by their parents. All unclaimed children will be taken to the Child Standby Muster Station and then distributed to their assigned lifeboat station. The team will distribute the life jackets to the children and help put them on correctly.

## INTERNET:

For your convenience, we have 24-hour Internet service available in the Internet Café. Here you can email, chat online with your friends at home, access your AOL account and surf the Net. Basic time charge is .75 per minute. See the Internet Manager for the great plans we have to offer.

## NCL KID'S CREW

Although the inside of the program listed the basic program requirements, there are a few additional specifics you need to know. If you have any questions, feel free to speak with the Youth Program Supervisor. Call 12510.

- Children are assigned to their appropriate age group based on the age at sailing, and the ships manifest. It is for the safety of all participants that children are not allowed to switch age groups. We regret that no exceptions can be made.
- Activities may be altered to accommodate the needs of the children that participate at any time.
- Our programs are very active and for the safety of your child, proper foot-ware is required. No flip-flops or sandals, please.
- Youth Staff are not able to assist children in the washrooms and do not change Diapers or Pull-Ups under any circumstance.
- Our beepers do not work ashore, therefore any parents with children requiring a beeper will not be allowed to leave the vessel if a child is in program or group sitting.
- Children with any symptoms of illness may be required to see the medical center before being admitted to the program.
- Parent Pick-Up Times are very important, as the Youth Staff have other duties and responsibilities as part of the Cruise Director's Staff.
- Light snacks are often served during our programs so it is imperative that all allergies and medications are noted on registration forms.
- Youth Staff is not included in onboard gratuities.

## SAFETY SPECIFICS & EMERGENCY INFORMATION

In the event of an emergency we will take all the children down to the Child Muster Station Located in the Le Bistro Restaurant (Station E), Deck number 6 Midship, where parents may collect their child/children. If the Le Bistro Restaurant can not be used, we will proceed to Bliss Ultra Lounge area, located on Deck number 7 Aft. If the Abandon Ship Signal is heard and there are still children left, the Youth Staff will escort the child/children into to the nearest lifeboat. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to ask a member of the youth staff.

To inquire about a lifejacket for your child, please speak to your stateroom steward, or be aware they are kept at designated stations and distributed by crew in an emergency.

We also ask that you and your children are aware of the ships rules and regulations stated inside the Freestyle Daily.

## LATE NIGHT GROUP SITTING & PORT PLAY

"Late Night Fun Zone" and "Port Play" are both group-sitting services, run by the Youth Staff. All activities take place in the Kid's Crew facilities, and all the requirements and procedures apply. The charge for this service is \$6.00 per hour, per child, and \$4.00 per hour for each additional sibling in the same immediate family. Charges are applied directly to your onboard account. Families wishing to use these services must be signed-up by 10:30pm the night of desired Late Night Group Sitting, and 10:30pm the evening prior to desired Port Play, for these services to run. Please see a member of the Youth Staff at the Kid's Crew facility to sign up.

## YOUTH PROGRAM DISCIPLINE POLICY

We use a four-step Discipline Policy to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all the children that participate in our program. It is strictly enforced and we appreciate your cooperation and kind understanding.

**Step 1: Warning:** The Youth Counselor addresses the child and it is explained that his/her behavior is unacceptable and needs to be improved immediately.

**Step 2: Time Out:** If the child continues to disobey the Youth Counselor, a time out is issued and the parents are notified at pick up time.

**Step 3: Suspension:** If a time out is not effective in eliminating the inappropriate behavior, the parents are located and the child is grounded from the program for 24 hours. The child is then welcomed back, but if there is a reservation on the part of the Youth Counselor, a parent may be required to attend with their child.

**Step 4: Dismissal:** Once the child is allowed back into the program after the initial dismissal, if any disobedient behaviors continue, the child will no longer be allowed to participate.
