

# EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT CARNIVAL YOUTH EXPERIENCE ABOARD THE LIBERTY®



Our Youth Program consists of 3 different areas. **CAMP CARNIVAL<sup>SM</sup>** for children between 2 and 11 years, **Circle "C"** for teenagers between 12 and 14 years old and **Club O<sub>2</sub><sup>SM</sup>** for teens 15-17 years. Our programs provide daily, complimentary, supervised, fun-filled and age appropriate activities. Our programs are activity based and our goal is to create an environment similar to what children/teens would experience at a summer camp.

## THE PLAYROOM

**CAMP CARNIVAL<sup>SM</sup>** is a 4200 square foot area located on Deck 12 forward. It is equipped with a room full of video gaming with a large selection of games. We also have arts and crafts that include a 5-color sand art machine, double spin art cabinet, and a candy art machine. Additionally, we have Plasma Screen for **MOVIE NIGHTS**. The playroom is stocked with games, toys, puzzles, books and traditional arts and crafts supplies. The above activities are available for all Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup> participants under the supervision and/or instruction of our trained and qualified Camp Carnival Staff. New innovative activities included aboard the Liberty® are: Individual Pizza Making, Cake Decorating & Water Wars. We also have enhanced specialty programs exclusive to Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup> that we offer fleet wide. These programs are designed by our qualified Camp Carnival Staff onboard who have some background in the different areas of expertise. The phone number of Camp Carnival is 1140 and 1141

## SPECIALTY PROGRAMS

- H2Ocean<sup>SM</sup>**: Science based program incorporating hands on projects
- SeaNotes<sup>SM</sup>**: Introduces kids to different musical instruments & genres
- Edu-Cruises<sup>SM</sup>**: Fun interactive projects focusing on cultures, landmarks, history & geography
- Water Colors<sup>SM</sup>**: Kids create their own artistic masterpieces & learn techniques employed by professional artists
- ExerSeas<sup>SM</sup>**: A recreational fitness program that encourages kids to "get out and play" through intense physical activity
- A-B-Seas<sup>SM</sup>**: Promoting reading and education in a fun learning environment for children and their families

- o **AGE GROUPS & AGE POLICY:** The age groups for supervised activities are 2-5 years, 6-8 years and 9-11 years. Carnival's policy is to group children together according to their age group as activities are based upon age appropriate activities.
- o **HOURS:** Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup> operates everyday from early morning until 10:00pm free of charge. We offer morning, afternoon and evening activities as well as supervised free play. The Playroom is closed during lunch during sea days as well as the hour prior to dinner each evening. Please check the capers for specific times. Please note that Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup> is not a daycare facility but an activity based program. We therefore ask that the child/children do not exceed the recommended 6 hour a day attendance at Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup>.
- o **BABYSITTING:** Babysitting takes place every evening from 10pm - 3am in the playroom. There is no in-cabin babysitting provided. The charge for this service is \$6/hour for the first child in a family and \$4/hour for each additional sibling. This fee is charged directly to the guests' Sail and Sign accounts.
- o **MEALS:** Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup> provides "CHILDREN'S ONLY" dinners most nights. These dinners take place in the Lido Restaurant. We encourage Parents to pick up their children for ALL meals on both port and sea days. Lunch is not provided on sea days however if you are on a Shore Excursion on a port day we will provide lunch for your child/children.
- o **CHILDREN UNDER 2 YEARS OLD:** Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup> is unable to accept children under the age of TWO during regular operating hours. However, infant - 2 year olds are welcome in the Playroom each evening from 10pm to 3am and on port days (during the specified times) for babysitting. A fee applies for babysitting services...\$6.00 per hour for the first child and \$4.00 for each additional sibling. In addition to the above services for infants, we offer our Family Play times, where parents can come into the playroom with their Under 2 to use the facilities or leave them in the care of the Camp Carnival Staff. Family Playtime is available on every sea day from 12pm-2pm or 1-3pm (depending on the ship); during this time, only parents and their infants can be in the playroom. Camp Carnival Staff do not provide babysitting in guest cabins.
- o **2-8 YEAR OLDS SIGN IN/OUT POLICY:** Parent/Guardian must specify in the registration form which adults over 18 are authorized to sign-in or sign-out the child. All designated adults will be required to present his/her Sail & Sign Card at both sign in/sign out. For the safety of the children, there are no exceptions to this rule. Nametags should be left with the Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup> Staff after activities.
- o **9-11 YEAR OLDS SIGN IN/OUT POLICY:** Children 9 YEARS OLD AND OVER are free to sign themselves in/out of Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup> as they choose at any time and for any reason. Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup> is not responsible for children 9 years old and over once they have signed themselves out of a Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup> Activity. Children are not permitted to sign themselves out after 10:00pm. After 10:00pm 9-11 year olds must be picked up by their parent from the Slumber Party (Babysitting fee applies after 10:00pm). Parents that do not want their 9-11 year olds to sign themselves in & out of our activities will be REQUIRED to sign their child in & out when attending Camp Carnival<sup>SM</sup>. If the parent/legal guardian chooses to change this policy and allow the child to sign in/out by themselves they must contact the Youth Director.

- o **BEEPER/PHONE POLICY:** All parents with children 5 years old and under will receive a complimentary beeper /phone on the first day of the cruise for usage throughout the voyage; however, all beeper must be returned in good condition by the last night of the cruise to avoid a charge. These beeper/ phone will enable the Camp Carnival Staff to contact parents in case a child is seriously unhappy, ill, misbehaving, continuously asking for their parents, and especially in case of emergencies. For this reason we do encourage parents to bring the beeper/ phone with them when leaving their children so Camp Carnival Staff are able check that beeper/phone is in working order. Should a beeper/ phone be returned broken, damaged or not returned at all, the cost of the beeper/phone will be automatically charged to the guest's Sail & Sign® Account.
- o **RENTALS:** Camp Carnival® now offers strollers, travel swings, bouncy seats and game boy rentals. Please check with the Camp Carnival Staff for specific details.
- o **EMERGENCY PROCEDURE:** A special procedure for children is in place in case of a ship's emergency. All children 11 years old and younger will receive a wrist band specifying their muster station. Any children participating in Camp Carnival® will be brought directly to their muster stations to be re-united with their families in case of an emergency.



## CIRCLE "C"™



**THE CIRCLE "C"™ LOUNGE:** Circle "C"™ is located on Deck 4 forward. It is equipped with video gaming equipment with a large selection of games. The lounge is also stocked with board games, puzzles, books and arts and crafts supplies. The activities and equipment are available for all Circle "C"™ participants under the supervision of our trained and qualified Circle "C"™ Director. Some innovative activities provided at Circle "C"™ aboard the Liberty® are Individual Pizza Making, Jewel Making & Rocket Making. The phone number to receive further information about Circle "C"™ is 1140/1141

- o **HOURS:** Circle "C"™ operates from late morning until 12:00am free of charge on sea days. Circle "C"™ activities are normally closed for lunch hours on sea days as well as the hours during dinner each evening. On port days they operate from late afternoon to 12:00am. One port day during the cruise a teen shore excursion is offered for the teens to go out together on a tour. Please check the capers for specific times.
- o **SIGN IN/OUT POLICY:** There is no sign in and out policy for the 12 – 14 year olds. They are free to come and go as they choose to activities.



## CLUB O2™



**THE CLUB O2™ LOUNGE:** Club O2™ is located on Deck 5 midship inside the Without Batteries Arcade. It is equipped with a DJ Booth for parties, video gaming equipment with a large selection of games. We also have Plasma Screens for Movie Nights and a chill area for the teens to relax. The lounge is also stocked with board games and puzzles. The activities and equipment are available for all Club O2™ participants under the supervision of our trained and qualified Club O2™ Director. Some innovative activities provided at Club O2™ aboard the Liberty® are: Battle of the Sexes, Photo Hunt & Water Wars. The phone number of Club O2™ is 5013.

- o **HOURS:** Club O2™ operates from early afternoon until 1:00am free of charge on sea days. Club O2™ activities are normally closed for during dinner hours each evening. On port days they operate from late afternoon to 1:00am. One port day during the cruise a teen shore excursion is offered for the teens to go out together on a tour. Please check the capers for specific times.
- o **SIGN IN/OUT POLICY:** There is no sign in and out policy for the 15 – 17 year olds. They are free to come and go as they choose.

## IMPORTANT FORMS

All participants in Youth Programs must complete a Registration and Medical Release Form. These forms indicate the child/teen's specific information such as stateroom number; muster station, dinner seating and table number. In addition, the Medical Release form gives Camp Carnival® and Circle "C"™, the authorization to care for their child/teen in case of an emergency. Please note that by filling out the registration and medical release form you agree to all terms and conditions as the Policies and Procedures set out by Camp Carnival® and Circle "C"™.

## YOUTH PROGRAMMING STAFF

All Youth Programming Staff are either college educated or have experience in a related field (i.e. Education, Recreation, Child Psychology, etc...), or they have had professional working experience with children (i.e. Teaching, Camp Counselor, Youth Recreation Director, Nanny, Day Care Worker, Teen Work Experience etc...). Currently, there are over 300 Youth Programming Staff fleet wide depending on the time of year. There are between 13 to 16 staff members aboard the CARNIVAL LIBERTY®

## POLICIES ONBOARD

Outside of the Youth Programs, parents are responsible for their children's behavior and compliance with Carnival's® onboard policies and use of facilities.

- o **Spa Carnival®:** Please note that guests under 12 are not permitted in these facilities. An adult must accompany guests between the ages of 12 and 16 at all times.
- o **Casino:** Please note that guests under 18 are not permitted in these facilities.
- o **Swimming Pools:** Lifeguards are not on duty at the pool. Our pools are not designed for diving. Please note that there are height restrictions for children to use the slides. Children in diapers or those who are not toilet trained are not allowed to use our pools due to the United States Public Health regulations.
